

Bunting project

Following the success of our wall-hanging we decided to do it again. This time with an ongoing bunting project, so why not join in?...

The Stitchlinks' wall-hanging, celebrating our first birthday was a resounding success, so we decided to do it again. To mark Stitchlinks' second Birthday, on January 23rd 2008, we thought we would celebrate 'Friendship'. So we invited our members to design a pennant of bunting in their preferred medium (knitting, cross stitch, etc).

This project has since become and ongoing one, which means that all new members will have the opportunity to contribute to this wonderful team effort. Plus those who wish to contribute more than once can do so!

The design needs to be your own original to avoid copyright

issues and maximise the buntings' future publicity as we'd like to show it off at exhibitions, shows and meetings!

Your design can be triangular or rectangular made to the dimensions shown on the diagram below and should express your message about friendship, knitting and stitching. Each should be accompanied by a small parcel tag containing a handwritten, personal message signed with your first name only. If you can, it would be great if your tags and words could be preserved by laminating. That way the final bunting will look beautiful and have our thoughts fluttering into the future, reminiscent of prayer flags.

Please send completed items 'ready to go' with a 2cm high hem (as illustrated) – you'll need to add your preferred seam allowance if your working medium requires it. If you need any clarification please see the Mini-make topic on the Forum, or contact Betsan via email (betsan@stitchlinks.com).
